- 4. Ask each resident/address if they have any resident skills or services which would be of benefit to our community and if we could list it in the new directory, such as: babysitting, lawn mowing, TV repair, plumbing, tutoring, notary services, etc. Record each resident service or skill and person to be listed, such as John Doe or John Doe's son or daughter.
- 5. Ask each resident/address if they have any profession or business they would like to advertize in the directory, such as an attorney, an electrician, a home remodeler, etc. Advertizement is done in the form of business cards and at a cost of \$10.00 per card.
- 6. Please complete all work by the end of November . I do not expect you to make unreasonable attempts to contact all residents, but two or three attempts should be made. If you cannot make personal contact, try a phone call to save unnessary trips. Return all forms and money to me by Saturday, December 6 . Do not hesitate to call me if you have any problems.
