### GREENWAY DOWNS COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT PLAN

A meeting of representatives from Fairfax County, an engineering firm and homeowners on Woodlawn, West George Mason, and Cameron Road is scheduled for Monday night, 8:00 p.m. in the Devonshire Elementary School Library. The purpose is to introduce the firm of Patton, Harris, Rust and Associates to the neighborhood and to discuss problems and developments on street improvements. Homeowners on those streets have already received a letter from the county advising them of this meeting.

As this improvement program will eventually affect all homeowners in Greenway Downs, all are invited to attend. The three streets mentioned earlier are the next streets scheduled for improvements; Greenway will be the first under construction.

### CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS

Those residents who received easement requests from the county concerning improvements to Greenway Boulevard are reminded to mail back those papers. Construction cannot begin until all concerned reply.

### CUB SCOUTING
