



## SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM

The Fairfax County Recreation Department is again planning to operate a neighborhood playground program at Devonshire for elementary age children. It will run from June 25 - August 3. No program on July 4. Registration is \$2.00 to help cover expenses. This amount is a voluntary contribution, however. It will operate Monday-Friday from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Children are expected to go home for lunch, but if no one is home and other arrangements cannot be made, the child may bring a bag lunch from home and eat at school.

Registration will be held on Friday, June 22 from 8:30 - 11:30 AM. Some volunteer help is needed to assist the Recreation Leader. The program will feature a variety of recreation activities such as sports, games, arts and crafts, dance, story-telling, drama and special event functions.

There is also a program for children with special needs such as those who are physically and/or mentally retarded. If you have any questions about either program, you are asked to call 691-3292 for information.
