GREENWAY DOWNS ELECTION RESULTS

Unofficial results from Greenway Precinct indicate that 635 people voted, out of a total of 1,252 eligible to vote. Godwin carried the precinct with 324 votes as compared with 311 for Howell. For Lieutenant Governor, Republican John Dalton received 309 votes, Democrat J. Harry Michael 175, and Independent Flora Crater 123. In the race for Attorney General, Democrat Andrew Miller was a big winner with 353 votes, over the 240 received by M. Patton Echols. For member of the House of Delegates from the Eighteenth Legislative District, the results were as follows: Democrat Mary Cahill 246, Independent Elizabeth Burch 82, Republican Byron Andrews 259, Democrat Dorothy McDiarmid 325, Republican Vincent Callahan 341, Democrat Kenneth Plum 249, Republican Wyatt Durrett 306, Democrat Raymond Vickery 246, Republican William Evans 261; Democrat Carrington Williams 283, Republican David Sutherland 288.
