

Death of Mrs. Tripp

Mrs. Sarah S. Tripp, wife of Mr. S. D. Tripp, died at the home of Mr. J. M. Smoot, of Falls Church, of Bright's disease, aged 64 years.

Mr. and Mrs. Tripp have resided on their estate on the edge of Falls Church for a number of years. To be near her church and friends they came to the home of Mr. Smoot last fall, where they remained for the winter.

Mrs. Tripp is survived by her husband, Mr. S. D. Tripp, and son, Rev. Percy Tripp, a professor in the Chinese University at Tein Sein, China. Mrs. Tripp was a devoted wife and mother, a kind neighbor and friend, and a most lovable Christian character. She always took a deep interest in all charitable work. Her love for the welfare of her church was manifested by the donation of all the stone for the erection of the beautiful stone church recently erected in Falls Church by the members of the Columbia Baptist Church and where she was always present for every service when her health permitted.

Mrs. Tripp' funeral took place from the Columbia Baptist Church, Rev. W. S. O. Thomas coordinating the services.

The remains were taken to Alexandria and placed in a vault for the present and later will be taken to Greenwood cemetery, Brookly, N.Y. for interment.
