The Greenway Downs Citizens Association (GDCA) is a non-profit, nonpartisan association of residents that represents approximately 480 households in one of oldest neighborhoods in Falls Church, Fairfax County. The GDCA is represented by a board of directors.

The Greenway Downs neighborhood was carved out of a 100 acre farm in 1927 but the neighborhood as we know it today was not created until 1942, when a group of neighbors decided to join together to get Fairfax County to hear their collective concerns.

Today, Greenway Downs is featured in Arlington Magazine as one of 10 great neighborhoods in Northern Virginia. The GDCA is proud to be both one of the oldest and most active civic associations in Northern Virginia. With support from its members, the GDCA board provides activities for the community throughout the year and represents the interests of Greenway Downs to local officials.

### Supervisor Dalia Palchik Updates

Dalia serves as the Providence District Supervisor and now lives in our neighborhood.



Greetings, Greenway Downs neighbors! I am so delighted to represent you on the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors for the Providence District. I have served on the Board since 2020, and previously served as your representative on the School Board. In addition to representing you, I am thrilled that as of December 2022, I am also your neighbor. My family and I, including my husband Jeffrey, baby daughter Sivan, mother-in-law Rochelle, and pug Maggie are thrilled to live in Greenway Downs. We love this community and are so grateful for the warm welcome we've received.

I believe that communication is critical when representing you, and that is why when I took office, I created the first electronic newsletter for the Providence District. I share information about community events, board actions, county updates, and more. If you have not yet had a chance to sign up, I encourage you to do so and to read previous issues on my page:

FairfaxCounty.gov/Providence. I love feedback, so please let me know if you'd like to see additional information or have items to share or include in my newsletter. As we come out of the pandemic, our service on the Board of Supervisors has turned to recovery and investment. That includes supporting our small businesses, schools and early childhood education, county workforce hiring and retention, environmental initiatives, and more. Many of you may have questions related to the latest real estate assessments you received from the Department of Tax Administration.

Due to demand outpacing housing stock in the region, we have seen assessments rise (they are based on house sales in the area). We know this is a challenge for residents, especially those on fixed incomes. In addition to our expanded tax relief program for seniors and individuals with disabilities, the county's main source of revenue in Virginia is through our real estate taxes, and the Board has not yet set the final tax rate.
