- **Old Business**
  - **Approve minutes from last meeting** - Approved
- **New Business**
  - **Treasurer's Report – Jenny**
    - Jenny would like another person who doesn't have check writing authority to have access to the bank account so there are checks and balances, succession planning in the event Jenny can no longer be treasurer, and for honest and ethical bookkeeping.
    - Currently no issues with the budget.
  - **Neighborhood signs – Jenny**
    - Quote is \$1,600 for the flat, painted sign. We are waiting on the proof. Should be three or four days once it's approved.
  - **Summerfield RPPD and truck restrictions complaint - Kevin**
    - The GDCA board received a complaint from Summerfield residents about parking and trucks violating the No Truck signs. Now that Cameron has RPPD parking along the full length of the street, Summerfield is going to see the ripple effects of commercial business parking on the west side of Summerfield which does not have RPPD. The GDCA will continue to monitor complaints.
  - **Follow up discussion on the next GD Directory - Sara**
    - The directory and the GDCA membership drive are on a two-year cycle. The membership form, which comes out in the Spring newsletter, collects information for the upcoming Directory. So, a proposal is introduced to concentrate the membership drive in May, and the directory printing in the fall. The board agrees.

- **Cavalier Trail parking issue-ongoing – Sara**
  - The GDCA received a complaint from a resident about parking along Cavalier Trail. The parking is not illegal but has caused the roadside to deteriorate. The GDCA will contact the residents along Cavalier to talk about recourse and options.
- **Lee Highway Revitalization - Jenny**
  - Revitalization of Lee Hwy is underway and a small group of neighborhood residents plan to get together at the end of March to begin meeting. A civic alliance is tentatively planned between Greenway Downs and the Falls Church City Section of Greenway Downs.
- **Other:**
  - Linda Smyth is retiring from Fairfax County
  - A logo contest is forthcoming. More details to come.
  - The GDCA received a complaint about a truck parked illegally on Summerfield. Unfortunately, the board does not have recourse when trucks illegally park as violations occur on a case-by-case basis and some trucks have legitimate reasons to park in residential neighborhoods. The GDCA recommends obtaining proof of illegal parking activity and the GDCA will act or refer residents accordingly.
